
- Remove all packaging and ensure the ramps have not been damaged in transit. Retain packaging.
- Carefully read the instructions and warning texts before using the ramps.
- Keep instructions for reference.
- On each ramp you will find a label that shows the maximum permitted load for the ramp.
- Take care when handling ramps at all times as edges can be sharp, especially where the ramp has been in contact with hard surfaces.

TO DEPLOY


- 1. Ensure the ground/surface at both upper and lower levels is firm and stable.
- 2. Release the latch as shown and fully extend both telescopic ramps. (Pic 1)
- 3. Check ramp is long enough to cover the step/rise.
- 4. Note: top and bottom ends of the ramps differ. (Pic 2 & 3)
- 5. Position the ramps the required width apart. The wheelchair should travel up the ramps easily.
- 6. Ensure the ramps do not become dislodged in use.
- 7. Check the ramps are firmly located and stable each time they are used.
- 8. To store after use, release the latch as shown and fully slide the sections back together ensuring the latch engages.

MAINTENANCE

- The ramps should be stored in a clean, dry place.
- If the ramps become damaged or slippery in any way they should not be used.
- The ramps may be cleaned with normal cleaning products and left to dry before use.
- Maximum recommended cleaning temperature 50°C; please enquire for further details on use with industrial cleaning machines.
- For disposal of this product, please liaise with a metals recycling contractor.

WARRANTY

- The ramps carry a 12-month warranty for normal use, conditions apply.
- Use other than published/intended will void the warranty.
- The ramps are not designed for permanent outside use and must not be fixed down.
- Any modification/repair other than by manufacturer will void the warranty.
