

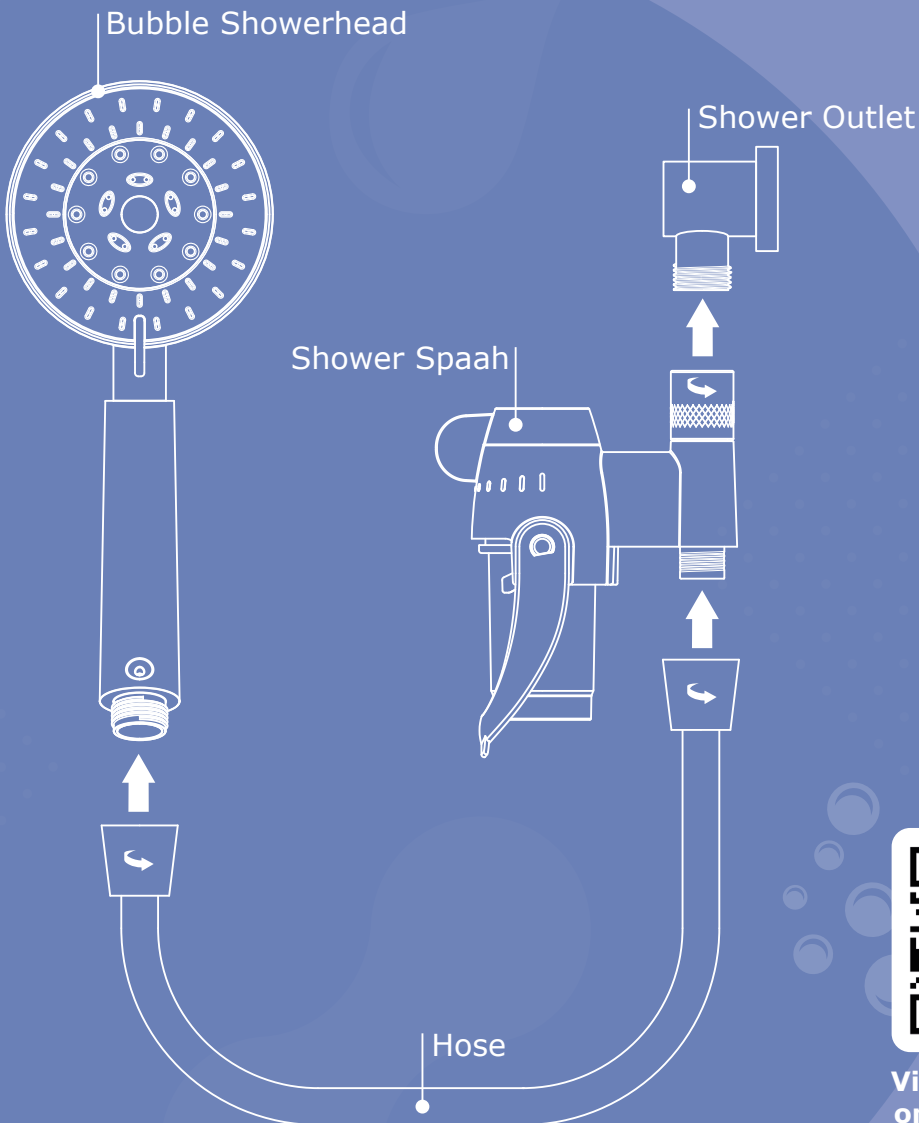

# INSTRUCTIONS

## 1. INSTALLATION

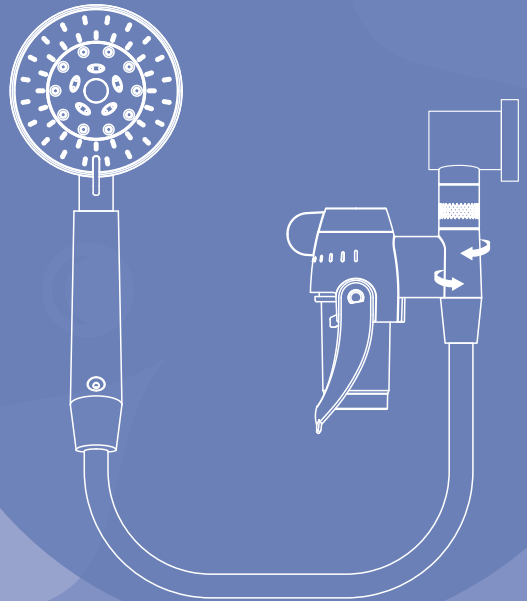
- Unscrew your hose from your shower outlet.
- Screw the top of the ShowerSpaah onto the outlet. (Hand tight only)
- Screw your hose onto the bottom of the ShowerSpaah. (Hand tight only)
- Unscrew your existing showerhead and replace with the new Bubble showerhead.

## 2. INSTALLATION COMPLETE

You can rotate the ShowerSpaah left and right to the most convenient position.



## 3. GETTING STARTED

- Always turn the water off to refill
- Lift the lever all the way and pull out the refill towards you.
- Pour in your favourite soap, replace the refill and close the lever all the way back down.
- Turn on the water and adjust the soap.



## **FAQs**

### **How do I turn the soap off?**

Just turn the control all the way to the front and the soap will stop.

### **How long should the soap last?**

That depends on how far you turn up the soap control but should last several showers. It also depends on the soap and your water pressure.

### **Can I use any soap?**

Most soaps and shampoos work just fine. Some of the highly moisturising products work less well and we don't recommend any exfoliation soaps with bits in.

### **Will it clog up my shower?**

The soap is thoroughly mixed with the water before it gets to the shower so no danger of clogging up. In fact the soap can help keep the inside of your shower head cleaner.

### **Specification**

Water pressure 1-3.5 Bar (15-50 PSI). Water temp 5-40C.  
Connection threads 1/2" inch.

### **Warranty**

ShowerSpaah provides a 1 year warranty under normal use and will replace the product for free but customers should pay return postage. This warranty only applies where defect has arisen from faulty manufacture, parts or workmanship and the product is installed and used according to the instructions.
