#### How to attach the spine

The spine can be secured in two positions on the Permaramp at the end, or set back on the slope to allow for protruding thresholds, e.g. uPVC door sills.

#### OPTION A

### Low Leg Assembly

For heights of 7.5 - 15cm (3 - 6ins)

- 1. Fit Low Leg Insert into Bracket
- 2. Attach Bracket to PA/PAW Spine with Spine/Bracket Bolts and M8 Flange Nuts
- 3. Assemble using correct Leg Screw as required



#### OPTION B Standard/High Leg Assembly

1. Fit Main Leg Outer to Bracket and secure with Leg Securing Bolt and Nut





3. Then attach the Bracket and leg assembly to the PA/ PAW Spine with Spine/Bracket Bolts and M8 Flange Nuts

#### Gradients

All leg/foot configurations can be used for ramp gradients of up to 1:6. Simply loosen nut above foot as required and tilt to required angle.

Permaramp-Adjust has been successfully tested to support loads in excess of the stated capacity. The ramp itself must be securely fixed to prevent excessive side-ways load or movement being supported by the Permaramp-Adjust leg. 90/120/150cm lengths must be secured at least one end of the ramp. 180cm and longer must be secured both ends. Use minimum two secure fixings to ground each foot.



Refer to all images and ensure all components, fixings and fasteners are used and secured correctly before use.

### The ultimate semi-permanent uPVC threshold bridging accessory



#### **Important Information:**

- Ideal for inward-opening and sliding door types
- Ask for assistance with any other applications
- An additional wedge type ramp can be used inside to increase the height range
- Width: 70cm (27.5ins) Length: 45cm (18ins)
- The stored flap is raised above the main Permaramp surface
- Max. inside height depends on slope of the Permaramp. Gentler slope = more inside height. As a guide, 1:12 slope outside = approx. 10cm (4ins) height inside

#### Installations

- 1. Install so top lip of Permaramp is as close to threshold as possible ensuring installation does not interfere with door operation
- 2. Ensure the flap folds fully down onto the Permaramp
- 3. Strap handle can be fitted either side of flap








Observe product weights and use appropriate correct manual handling techniques and equipment. Be aware of pinch points between moving parts.







Important: Take care to lower the handrail onto the elbows equally.



- 1. Fit the elbow, then insert the Ratchet Lever Bolts through the small hole side of the handrail
- 2. Apply the Flange Nut finger tight, then tighten firmly using the ratchet lever. (Squeeze the red button and lever to adjust the position as
- 3. Fit the handrail and insert the Coach Bolts from the ramp side through the upper and lower square holes. Secure with the Nylon Wing Nuts on the outside.

#### Capacity:

**Important Note:** The stated product capacity requires product to be securely fixed to the ground.

#### Permaramp - Quickrails dimensions:

- Adds 12.5cm (5ins) to the ramp width each side the Quickrails are added
- The Quickrail length is the same as the ramp length and can be adjusted if required.
- Handrail height is 92cm (36ins)
- The handrails uprights are 45cm (18ins) from each end of the ramp.

#### Maintenance

- All fixings and fittings should be regularly checked to ensure they have not become dislodged or loose in use and are secure and safe.

- If the ramps become damaged or slippery or any fixings and fittings become loose in any way they should not be used (contact supplier/manufacturer).
- Care should be taken in extreme conditions, such as snow and ice, that the surface is cleared which is the same as any roadside pathway.
- The ramps may be cleaned with normal cleaning products and left to dry before use.
- Maximum recommended cleaning temperature 50°C.
