

Harrier Toilet Frame

User Instructions

Maximum User Weight:

General Safety Warning

Please ensure these instructions are fully read and understood before installation/use. Retain these instructions in a safe place for future reference.

Intended Purpose

The Harrier toilet frame is designed to aid the user to sit and rise from the toilet. It has a low crossbar which enables it to fit fully under most toilets. The open rear design allows carers better access to the client.

Fitting Instructions

- 1. Turn toilet frame upside down on floor/ flat surface.
- 2. Adjust to the correct height by removing pin clips, sliding the extension legs to required position and replace pin clips.
- 3. Ensure all leg extensions are secured to the same adjustment hole to ensure even height, and prevent rocking.
- 4. Place the toilet frame over the toilet

Safety Precautions

- Do not exceed the maximum user weight limit.
- Ensure an even floor surface to prevent Rocking.
- Inspect at regular intervals for wear and damage.
- Do not use if rubber feet are damaged.



Cleaning Instructions

- Clean the frame and armrests regularly, use a general purpose, neutral detergent and warm water.
- Do not use an abrasive detergent, cleaner or cloth to clean or dry this product.
