Product Description & Intended Purpose

Designed for low impact rehabilitation and exercise this Pedal Exerciser is NOT a suitable alternative to a full size gym exercise bike or similar. It is ideal for those with reduced mobility or those who wish to complete a little gentle exercise. It incorporates a digital display to enable users to view cycles completed, RPM, duration and calories burned.

- Toe straps on pedals.

Safety Precautions

- CAUTION! As friction is increased, or during prolonged periods of vigorous exercise, the pedals and housing may become warm to the touch. Stop using the exerciser and allow to cool.
- Do not attempt to stand whilst using the exerciser.
- Ensure the exerciser is locked in the open position prior to use.
- Always place the exerciser on a flat, 'non-slip' surface. Never use on a wet floor or in a bathroom environment.
- Not suitable for use by children.

Installation Information: (Note: for detailed information refer to User Instructions)

- The product is supplied pre assembled. It simply requires unfolding.
- No tools or specialist skills are required to install, adjust or use the product.
- Installation time is approximately 5 minutes.

Cleaning

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Take care when wiping the digital display area.
- Please check the suitability of the cleaning product before use. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cloths as this will permanently damage the surface and invalidate any warranty.
- Allow the product to dry thoroughly prior to use.

Care & Maintenance

- Inspect the product regularly for signs of wear, pay particular attention to the condition of the pedals and rotating mechanism.
- Any suspected faults or damage should immediately be reported to the supplier and the product taken out of use.

Replacing the Battery:

- To access the battery, insert a small, flat ended screwdriver into the slots on both sides of the digital display to release the clips.
- Lift the display out of the housing. Take care not to damage the connecting wires.
- Replace the battery and re-insert the display. Ensure the clips 'click' back into position securely.

FAQ's

What sort of batteries does the exerciser require?

A single watch style battery is needed.

• What is the resistance like? Is it as easy as pushing air or hard work like pushing a mountain?

The level of resistance can be increased or decreased depending upon the ability of the user.

Is it possible to adjust the height of the exerciser?

No the exerciser has a fixed height but you can adjust your position by moving your position on the chair or the chair itself.
